## Introduction

I started blogging in September of 2011 and have tried to churn out a blog a day since then. By and large, except for a few holiday, vacation, or out of the range of modern technology days (never more than a handful of them in a year) I have succeeded.

This is very good for me. It keeps me writing, it keeps the juices flowing. I have, in that time, put out one novel and several collections of poetry.

Each blog is immediately followed by a short, rhyming tweet condensing its message and promoting it to the world. Those form this book, the fourth in its series: *Twoems* (2012), *Rheets* 2013, *Rheets* 2014, and now *Rheets* 2015. That's well over a thousand poems, probably more than half the poems I've ever written, if we were counting like that, which, fortunately for lovers of literature, we're not. (You can check *Poems from Prague*, *Four Syllables on Water*, *155 Sonnets*, *The This of the That*, and others for lengthier and more significant works.)

I enjoy putting the book together. It gives me an excuse to read back through all of my rhyming tweets for the year (I must confess, despite a lack of sales or international fame and glory, I am my own favorite poet), and also to read through some of the blogs. I'm probably a better poet than I am a prophet. I predicted that Hillary would have a hard time winning the nomination, but I thought her main problem would be Martin O'Malley.

Of course, it was a big political year (remember Jade 15, the plot to take over Texas?), but it was also a year of some personal accomplishments for me. For one thing, I finished my first novel, *The Shit Guru*. It's an excellent book, in my own opinion. An interesting travelogue, a good depiction of life in Prague in the 90s and 00s, an insightful analysis of the Hippie lifestyle, and an entertaining story of a complex life.

It was a year when many new planets were discovered, AI made great leaps forward, I read and reviewed some books, saw and reviewed a few films, and quite a few famous people left this life.

These are the kinds of things I write about.

As poems, most of them are pretty insignificant, but together they are a historical record, a reminder of a year that, like every year, altered the course of human history forever. I hope you enjoy reading them as much as I enjoyed writing them.
